


There are several ways to set-up an RSS feed.
This presentation will walk you through setting up an RSS to your web browser and to your email.

1. Go to the www.fleta.gov website

2. Select the FLETA.gov RSS Feeds link on the left of the homepage in the Most Requested section

What is RSS?

RSS (Really Simple Syndication) is a free service that automatically sends information about new web content. RSS saves users from having to repeatedly visit favorite web pages to check for new content. FLETA.gov uses RSS to transmit content links which link back to FLETA.gov for everything from press releases to podcasts.



How Do I Use RSS?

Web browsers such as [FireFox](#) and [Internet Explorer](#) (version 7 and above only) have RSS reader ability built-in. You can also use one of the many dedicated RSS reader programs available. When finding a feed, make sure you include the entire feed URL. Also note that with popular portals such as [My Yahoo](#) and [iGoogle](#) you can easily add RSS feeds to your personalized home page.

The web browser will open. Now all you need to do is add the RSS feed to your content.

Really Simple Syndication (RSS) is a way for content publishers to make news, blogs, and other content available to subscribers. You can add your favorite RSS Feeds as subscriptions in Microsoft Outlook.

Get started


Using Outlook to subscribe to an RSS Feed is quick and easy and does not involve a registration process or fee. After you subscribe to an RSS Feed, headlines will appear in your RSS folders. 




